Ann Lovy on the Role of Spouses in Rotary

Yielding to the tremendous pressure, through humble requests, from the club President Dr. V.J.S. Vohra (Sunny), Ann Lovy Peter addressed Midtowners on the role of spouses in Rotary last Friday. From an organization that barred the entry of women as Rotarians to its fold till as far back as 1989, Rotary has come a long way in realizing and appreciating the role of women and Spouses of Rotarians in the life of a Rotary Club, said Lovy.

Ann Lovy emphasized the need of a proper orientation of a Rotarian's spouse right at the time of the induction of a new member. Clubs generally do not pay enough attention to orienting the spouses. Motivating the spouses would obviously strengthen the Rotarians to go ahead to achieve the objectives of Rotary. Involvement of the spouses should start from the time of induction of a Rotarian.

She began her talk by saying that the role of spouses in Rotary, in her perception, continuous to be a grey area. However it's an irrefutable fact of life that no Rotarian can rise to positions of leadership whether at the club level, district level or at the international level without the sincere support of his spouse and her genuine appreciation of the guiding principles of Rotary. This has been amply demonstrated by the examples of Rotarians both in India and abroad who have risen to leadership positions at the highest level with the active support of their spouses. She cited the examples of PRIP Raja Saboo, current RI President Bill Boyd and Rotary Foundation Trustee Ron Burton whose journeys in Rotary

War against Cancer was her mission. Her passion. She was not contended with 'Sahayta' alone. She also set up, Cancer Survivor's Club. She inaugurated her dream Project Sahayta Cancer Sahyog Building on September 30, 2006.

Social Work was a way of life with her. She was the wife of an Ex-Pilot of Indian Air Force. She was the In-charge for social welfare activities in the Air Force. She worked for the Blood Bank of the PGIMER, Chandigarh. She also worked in a Blind School. She was a member of International Confederation of Childhood Cancer Parents Organisation.

It seems, no one can change destiny. Neelu herself was diagnosed of Cancer. It spread to Lungs, Liver and Bones. She passed away on October 26, 2006.

Club Elections RY 2007-08

The Board of Directors, in the meeting held on November 26, 2006, has decided to call nominations from members of the Club for the office bearers for the Rotary Year 2007-08 and for President for 2008-09.

Section 5, Article I of the Bye-laws of Rotary Club of Chandigarh Midtown refers :-

- President 2008-09: Minimum 2 years on the Board of Directors at the time of assuming office.
- Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer: Should have been on the Board of Directors for one year at the time of assuming office.
- Four Directors, Jt. Secretary and Sergeant-at-Arms: Should have been member of the Club for at least 12 months at the time of election.
- The candidates for all the above posts should have maintained a minimum attendance of 65% in the 12 months preceding the elections.
