Thank you for your mail here below. We are safe and well here in Lugano. As most of us around here we are confined to our house since the beginning of March, but here in Ticino we are at least allowed to take a walk every day. In Italy people cannot do that, and that is hard.

It's indeed very dark times, and we feel fortunate that we can live a rather normal life in our house. I have many friends who are doctors, or work within the health system, and for them it has been extremely though in the past few weeks. Fortunately, we can now see the first signs of lower numbers of cases and deaths, and that gives us all hope that we have past the worst. But it will take months before we can hope to go back to a normal life again.

Please convey our warmest regards to all our Rotarian friends in your club. I trust the girls are fine and that they can finish their studies!






