As the speaker was to say at the end of his talk -gentlemen, if you got bored with the talk, the blame goes to Pallav, but if you liked it, well, thank you very much !

This, then, was how Er. M. Ramshekar, IAS, & currently the Transport Commissioner, Haryana, put across his informative talk on the urban scenario today. His talk covered a vast spectrum- as indeed any talk on this mega issue of what to do with the mega cities with all their mega problems.

Mega problems ? That would be the understatement of the century; giga-problems would be more apt a name ! Has anybody ever solved any big city problem ? You go & solve a small city problem - and the solution becomes the problem ! You provide better roads & transportation in a small city, & it starts to grow, because the city becomes a great place to live in. Provide great housing at a reasonable price, with all the basic amenities, & there are hordes of people who move in & the place is suddenly overcrowded. Provide electricity around the clock - that is enough reason for people to move

in from hundreds of miles away. Provide one little thing that is in short supply & the world will come to your doorsteps - in fact move right in !

Imagine the world a few centuries ago, and the painters who immortalized those serene pastoral scenes in their water colours. Well, the world has grown since then - and how ? The rate of urbanization is meteoric. What was originally basically an agrarian economy has changed drastically into an industrial one, with the resources of Planet Earth taking a hit. The world is expected to be more than 50% urbanized in next few years - with most of it happening in the developing countries. And another thing - over half of the city folk will be living in slums...

It's already happening, almost two out of every three people (that's 60%) in Mumbai are living in slums, or chawls, and another two lakh (that's almost half the population of the organized sectors of our city Chandigarh) are living, well, on the streets !



Real estate values in Mumbai are about the highest on earth. And global real estate agents have moved in for the kill. We have developers from the world over. The proof of the killing - of the 34 Lamborghinis sold in the country, 30 of them have been bought by builders. These Italian thoroughbreds cost upwards of Rs. 200,00,000/- each, a hundred times more expensive than the most common set of wheels - the Maruti !

The world population at the beginning of the twentieth century was a measly two billion, but it took a mere century after that for the population to more than treble to six & a half billion ! In fact the growth of our towns & cities has been a staggering 800% over the last century ! An analogy of your home catering to 40 people instead of 5, should demonstrate the problem !

The developed world already has an urban population of more than 75%. But here in India, with more than one third of the population living below poverty level conditions, mostly in the villages, the migration to urban centers will & has become a tidal wave.

Take our national capital, New Delhi. What was a quaint little capital of the decadent Mughal Empire exactly a century & a half ago, has bloated into one huge conurbation of Sonapat, Hapur, Meerut, Bulandshahar, Ghaziabad, NOIDA, Faridabad, Ballabhgarh, Palwal, Gurgaon (the fastest growing city on Earth!), Dwarka, Bahadurgarh & a host of other small towns & villages that have well, merged into Delhi. And the problems ? Well, you name it, you got it - traffic, cars, pollution, disease, hospitals, water, air, electricity, time, peace, housing, friendship - all aspects of life get hit here. For the average Chandigarhian, Delhi is not *jannat*, but *jahannum*; never mind what was written in the books of yore !

I myself remember the time (just a couple of decades ago) when going to the Qutab Minar was deemed a picnic out of town. Now, you have a multi-lane bypass to Gurgaon that is mostly jammed with traffic, right next to the minar - anytime of the day or night !

Why go so far ? Try getting out of Chandigarh. If you don't get stuck at the Zirakpur area, well, not to worry, there's another bottleneck just ahead at the bridge. The developers have bought up the earth all the way to Ambala & beyond. Try the road out to the west towards Kharar & beyond to Ludhiana & Ropar (oops, sorry, Roopnagar !). There isn't one square inch of land left for you to buy, or grow some vegetables.

Builders & developers have taken over. From Dubai there's Emaar, from Delhi, Parsvnath & a host of others. From Mumbai there's Raheja, plus from other cities in Punjab, Haryana & maybe even other parts of the country. Mohali has suddenly become the hot spot. PUDA has made an offshoot

GMADA, to handle the huge gold rush of developers moving in for the kill. Land prices have gone up from a few thousand a few years ago to over a billion per acre! So what? Emmar does fifty times as much of business per day - globally. Look at the stakes - everybody & his uncle wants to get on to the bandwagon.

What're you gonna do about it, dear pampered citizen?
