Rtn Ritu Singal, PPs, Rtns B L Ramsisaria, Chandgotia, Col Gill and PE Rtn Luther, Rtn Deepak Sood and our office Secretary V P Sharma. PDG Rtn Shaju Peter joined the group later. President of our inner wheel Club President Mrs. Gupta with IW members were their to receive the D G Dr. BD Gupta and teacher Ms Poonam spoke on the details of the course. Each student was presented a first aid kit by the first lady of the Distt Ann Neelam.

Visit to Some Major Projects

It was not possible to visit all he major projects of the Club due to constraints of time. The major projects that could not be included in the schedule were adequately covered by the President in his audio – visual presentations.

Home Care Nurse's Training

It is a one year course that is on – going for the last 14 years. There has been an average of 12-16 girls in each batch. The current course will graduate in May 2010. The training centre is being run by Dr B D Gupta in memory of his son Dr Vikrant Gupta. The District Governor expressed his appreciation by saying that such a project is the need of the day for the growing elderly population of the region. It is also a means to Women – Empowerment. Our inner wheel club takes a very strong and supportive interest in this project. They select the students for training.

The DG, first lady of the Distt Ann Neelam with Rtns and IW members then RVd at the Chandigarh Golf Association and proceeded to village Kishan Garh to visit two recipients of our interest free Micro Loans. The President led the convoy to visit the Micro Loan Projects.

Micro Loan Projects

The Project, a WCS Project, commenced in the year 1995-96 with contributions from the Rotary Foundations and Rotary Club Milano Sud-Est Italy, with an amount of about Rs 5 Lac. Two more WCS projects followed, one each, in the year 1998-99 and the current year 2009-10. The Club now has three Micro Loan

Projects with a total amount of Rs 20 Lac. More than 150 loanees have benefited by the interest free loans in improving their business and life and enabling them to educate their children. VP Rtn Arjan Singh conducted the DG and Ann Neelam to two such loanees.

Lakhbir Karyana Shop

Lakhbir Singh was loaned Rs. 20,000/- which has increased his daily turn over by more then Rs. 500/-. He is planning to increase this to about Rs. 800/- by June 2010.

Kewal Kishore Chawla

He also runs a Kiryana shop and has received Rs 30,000/- as Ioan. He is very happy and says that his turn over per day has increased by our average of about Rs. 1,000/-. He is expecting to raise it further by few hundred rupees. A Cheque of Rs, 15,000 was presented to Mr. Chawla to make the total loan to Rs. 30,000.

Both the loaners were very appreciative of Rotary and thanked the District Governor profusely.



The President then escorted the District Governor to visit the Club Projects in the village Khuda Ali Sher and Panchkula.

Khuda Ali Sher Training Centre

It handles two courses. One for 12-15 girls for a six month in tailoring embroidery and other facets for clothing. The second course is for 12-16 young boys to train them as electricians. 10 June 2010 is the graduation day for these boys & girls. Rtn Munish Johar, the Club Committee Chairman for these courses conducted the DG and explained the details of the training programme.







Training of Differently Abled Persons

The District Governor was escorted to the Training and Employment Institute for the Disabled Panchkula. The Institute is funded by the National Welfare Council for the Disabled and donations. It is managed by the Rotary Community Corps (RCC) Panchkula which was sponsored by our Club. Most of the members of the RCC are differently abled and they are active to help the disabled and carry out many projects to serve the community. They are a shining example of empathy, sympathy and service to the Community. Our Club has donated three computers for the Institute Computer Training Centre. The District Governor was touched by the courage and hopeful attitude

of the differently abled to face the realities of life. The D G Was particularly impressed and touched to see the differently abled children taking on the life and dealing with their problems with confidence and hope. A tricycle was presented to the RCC Panckula at the instance of PP Rtn VJS Vohra. The General Secretary of the RCC Panchkula, himself having an artificial leg is full of confidence and is enthusiastic to serve the community and thus enhance the image of Rotary.

The Party dispersed thereafter to meet at Hotel President at 18:30 Hrs for the Club Meeting.

In Vocational Service, berides the various Career and skill


development courses, awards for outstanding employers and members of the Society were organized after very careful selection of the awardees.


