Rotary Ideals and the Judiciary

Rotary and Judiciary, both are apolitical. Paul Harris, founder of Rotary was a Lawyer. The Lawyers, Judges and Law Academics have played vital role in furtherance of the Rotary ideals and goals. They have even been Rotary International Presidents and District Governors. Both these Institutions have a common goal, Rotary is a service oriented institution. Service to the community is its functional goal. The same is true in case of judiciary. Doing justice is the aim and objective of the judiciary. Doing justice is the best kind of service that can be rendered to the community and to the individuals. Therefore, 'service' is the common goal of both. Thus spake PP Dr. Balram Gupta, our Speaker at the last meeting.

One of the pillars of the Rotary is -Is it the Truth! "Justice is Truth-in-Action". If the judiciary is able to find the truth in different situations, that is justice-in-action. Thus, the meeting points, both of Rotary and Judiciary are common. In order to find the truth in any given situation between disputing parties, we need independent judiciary. Rotary is an independent institution with an objective mind to find the truth. IThe Indian judiciary occupies a high ranking place in the world judicial family. The same is true of Indian Rotarians. Indian Rotarians have held the highest position of Rotary International President. Their contributions are acknowledged in the Rotary world and beyond.

To be a Rotarian, one must be a good human-being. To be a Judge, one must be a good human-being. The professional ethics is equally important to both. The highest ethical standards are required to be followed by both. The Courts are open theatres. If a particular party feels aggrieved, they can appeal before the higher court. We have a hierarchy of courts, so that wrongs can be rectified. We are a democracy. The judgments are subjected to open criticism on sound grounds. The Summit Court changes its view if it is satisfied that the



earlier view was not correct legally. This is how the law grows. It would not be out of place to refer to the recent case of proposed impeachment of a High Court, Judge pending before the Indian Parliament. The Judge while being a Lawyer was appointed as a Receiver. As a consequence, he received certain amount of money. He got the same deposited in his own personal account. Number of years later, he was elevated as judge of the High Court. The issue came up before the High Court. The Single Bench decided against the judge. The matter came up before the Division bench on appeal. The division Bench decided in favor of the judge. No Special Leave Petition was filed. The panel of three-members was constituted by the Vice-President of India. It found that the judge was guilty of misconduct. It would be relevant to point out that the judge had returned that entire money along with interest. Accordingly, the Hon'ble Division Bench had found that there was no misconduct on the part of the judge. Now, the matter is to be placed before both the Houses of Parliament. If a Resolution is passed by both the Houses, the Judge would

stand impeached. If he is impeached, this would be the first impeachment in the constitutional history of India. There is one difficulty. The Division Bench of Calcutta High Court has already held him not guilty of misconduct. No appeal was preferred before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Accordingly, the decision of the Division Bench has attained finality. The moot point would be, can the Parliament over-rule the judicial decision which has already attained finality. The Parliament can amend the law. Can the Parliament take a view contrary to the judicial view, which has already attained finality? If a view is

taken contrary to that of Division Bench, will it not amount to contempt?

We need judicial ombudsman. It would serve a two-way traffic. The judge in question today has no forum where he could present his point of view. No one can be condemned unheard. The judicial Ombudsman can fill up this gap.

The future of the Indian Judiciary is good. The faith of people in judiciary is its main strength. This faith must be cemented and strengthened. We look forward to rich contributions both from Judiciary as also from Rotarians.
