The concept of RYLA VISHESH was explained by PP Dr. V.J.S. Vohra who has been empowering the disabled persons for last 41 years by providing artificial limbs and other facilities. Persons with disabilities make up an estimated 15 per cent of the world's population. Globally, they encounter many disadvantages in their societies and are often subjected to stigma and discrimination. They are largely excluded from civil and

political processes and are overwhelmingly voiceless in matters that affect them. In India there are 2.68 crore persons with disabilities. The Govt. has number of schemes and regulations like Persons with Disability Act since 1995, but still there is lack of sensitization. Whatever empowerment we see in the persons with disabilities is their own personal efforts. Rotary is aware of these difficulties being faced by disabled persons. The initiative taken by our club in holding RYLA VISHESH is part of many disability issues taken up on Rotary platform. Our club is committed to the cause of the disabled, and we look forward to the responsibility of Special RYLA every year!

For RYLA VISHESH we had counselling sessions by the experts, like Mrs. Sumedha Singh, to improve the communication skills of our very special participants, develop their inter personal




