

Hepatitis B testing camp

In the gracious presence of DG VP Kalta and District First Lady Rtn Veena Kalta, our club organised hepatitis B testing camp for safai mitras of ward 16 Panchkula. Total 20 sanitation workers were tested and all were negative, which means they are not vaccinated against HBV. President RCC Rakesh Valmiki put in tremendous effort to bring them together and lab tests was sponsored by Rotary.

President Dr Sanjay Kalra said that sanitation workers are at most risk of infection due to exposure to sharp and unsegregated waste from our homes and surroundings while risking their lives.



So it is our responsibility to protect them with HBV vaccine and save them from long term morbidity associated with the virus. Soon all three doses of Hepatitis B vaccine shall be given to them to the complete circle of protection amongst sanitation workers.

PP Rtn Kanan Diwan got the gift of Rotary when she married a young man RtnYoginder Diwan in 1960 and she has cherished this gift with love and special care.

Q. When did you join Rotary and what motivated you to join it?

A. My first introduction with Rotary was in 1960 when I married Rtn Yoginder Diwan and used to attend meetings as R'Ann in Karnal and Delhi. When we moved to Shimla in 1967, I was instrumental in forming Inner Wheel Club there and became its Secretary and later President. However, when my husband served as the District Governor, I as the First Lady got the opportunity to visit various clubs and was deeply inspired by the different humanitarian and service projects taken by different clubs. Some of these projects have become permanent in serving the community. However, In 2008 I joined Chandigarh Midtown in my own individual capacity.

Q. Please describe your tenure as President of the club.

A. I was installed the 39th President of the club by PRIP Raja Saboo in 2015-16. The signature project during this period was the construction of Community Toilet Block at Makhan Majra. Hand wash stations were also built in 12 schools. Besides, two new class rooms were built in Govt. Primary School, Raipur Kalan. In village Maloya, a vocational centre and an adult literacy centre were also started. Thus, it was a very satisfying year.

Q. Which other important projects have you been associated with?

A. As Director Community Service I was instrumental in construction of building of Govt. Primary School, Peermuchalla. As Project Chair for Dialysis Project we donated six dialysis machines to Guru Granth Sahib Sewa Society Sector 52 Chandigarh. It was done under Global Grant. I have never given importance to the positions in Club. My motto has been to serve the community as per my ability and my capacity.

On 25th May 2023 Project Sahyog was graced by the presence of one of the senior most Past District Governor Rtn Dr RS Parmar. Also present were District Chair Sahyog PP Salil Bali, PP Ashok Puri, District Chair Disability Empowerment PP Dr VJS Vohra, Rtn Brig JS Sabhatwal, R'Ann Indu Vohra and R'Ann Jyotie Sabharwal.

Five patients were discharged after satisfactory fitting of artificial limbs. Plaster cast / measurement was taken for 2 new patients. Thank you RC Mohali, RC Mohali Midtown, RC Panchkula and RC Mohali Silvercity for sponsoring the discharged patients.

Four assistive devices were provided to needy disabled persons. One tricycle was provided for disabled person, referred by RC Shahbad Markanda.

Amongst other beneficiaries were Mukesh and Poonam a married couple who are para Olympians and Table Tennis Champions. Both of them are polio victims, having deformity of lower limbs. Mukesh was provided Aluminum Crutches. Poonam needs a high quality Knee Ankle Foot Orthotic (KAFO) support to perform better while playing table tennis.
