The first regular meeting (actually second, first one being the Installation Ceremony!) of the Rotary year 2023-24, under the leadership of President Rtn Jeeten Bhambri and his team was held on July 14, 2023 at Hotel Shivalikview, Sector 17, Chandigarh. The meeting was also graced by the presence of PDG Rtn Dr K.A. Kuriachan from RI District 3201, PDG Yoginder Dewan and PP Rtn Rakesh Mittal of Rotary Club of Chandigarh City Beautiful.

In his welcome address, President Rtn Jeeten Bhambri thanked all present in large numbers, taking it as a great start to the new Rotary year. He announced few changes to be incorporated in our regular meetings during the year, which are:

- 1. The club projects being undertaken shall be showcased only during the last meeting of the month instead of the erstwhile practice of doing so in each weekly meeting. However, information about each project shall continue to be shared via whatsapp group to keep the members involved and updated on daily / regular basis.
- 2. The projects shall be showcased by the respective Directors themselves instead of the President showcasing all of them.

President Jeeten then invited IPP Rtn Dr Sanjay Kalra to felicitate the members who had bagged various awards at the District level on June 30, 2023. Dr Kalra thanked

Chief Guest PDG Rtn KA Kuriachan was introduced by PP Rtn Dr Balram Gupta. Dr Kuriachan of RI District 3200 (now 3201) was one of the World's Youngest Rotary Governor in the year 2001-02. Born in April 1965, he did his schooling in Coimbatore, Civil Engineering

(B.E.) from Bangalore University and an MBA from PSG College of Technology, Coimbatore, Master's degree in Applied Psychology and a Doctorate in Management from Bharathiar University. A Rotarian since 1989-90, he is a member of the Rotary club of Coimbatore Texcity and has served the Club and District in several capacities.

Appreciating the great efforts of Rtn Kuriachan, former President of India, H.E. Dr APJ Abdul Kalam invited to meet him personally and appraise about the functioning of the Road Accident Helpline project.

PDG Kuriachan is a Major Donor and has received the 'Significant Achievement Award' in 1997 and has been honored with several National and International Awards. He is happily married to Daisy, who herself is a Major Donor. They are blessed with two daughters - Maria, an Artificial Intelligence Manager working in

New York and Alice, working in Goldman Sachs, Bengaluru.

In his address, PDG Kuriachan commended the great work done by IPP Rtn Dr Sanjay Kalra and team 2022-23. He also acknowledged PP Dr Balram Gupta as an eminent figure as the former Director of National Judicial Academy. Looking at the enthusiasm of the Chandigarh Midtowners which culminated in forty six awards at the District level, Dr Kuriachan remarked that Chandigarh Midtown is not an ordinary club. He made a special mention of our own PDG Rtn Shaju Peter who is now settled in Kerala and is a member of Rotary Club of Mulanthuruthy in District 3201.
