

PDG Rtn Yoginder Diwan has been in the business of fruit farming and fruit processing. He got exposure to Rotary at a very young age and he breaths Rotary and lives by the four way test of Rotary. He is fondly known as the son-in-law of Chandigarh Midtown.

Q. What motivated you to join Rotary?

A. My earliest memory of Rotary is when I was visiting USA in 1957 as a member of Youth Farm Exchange Team. While staying with the farm family on their farm, I was invited to address a Rotary club on the 'culture and agriculture' of India. That was the first time I heard of and was introduced to Rotary. On my return from USA, I was invited by the clubs of Patiala, Panipat and Karnal to share my experience of Farm families and farming of America. Then on attaining the age of 25 I was invited to join Rotary Club of Karnal in 1960. In the same year I got married to Kanan and she became Rotary Ann. It perhaps makes me the oldest living Rotarian with maximum number of Rotary service years in the District.

Q. Please describe your Rotary journey.

A. The year when I joined Rotary, the boundary of our Rotary District extended from Mughal Sarai to Peshawar and the areas of present Districts 3070, 3090 and 3010. I distinctly remember being the youngest Rotarian of the club I was appointed as aide to District Governor Rizvi (the senior) from Lahore on official visit to our

In 1965 the family moved to Shimla and I joined Rotary club of Shimla where I served in all positions till I was asked to lead the club in 1976-77. In 1986, it was my good fortune that I was asked to lead GSE team to UK. I again moved to Parwanoo to set up Food Processing Industry there in 1990. The same year I formed Rotary club there and was the Chartered President of the Club. In 1995-96, I was elected as the District Governor, As District Governor, my main emphasis was to strengthen the Rotract movement. My fondest memory of Rotary service is establishing the Vocational and Community Centre with an outdoor sports centre in 10000 sq. meters covered area and an open air stadium and sports ground in 7000 sq. meters. The greatest satisfaction of my life is my 'hands on' involvement with Rotary projects and earning life long friends.

Q. Sir, you have done lot of community projects which are of permanent nature in your individual capacity, how have you helped PP Kanan Diwan in her projects when she was the President?

A. After moving our residence from Parwanoo to Chandigarh in the year 2000 we felt a little void in our Rotary activities. So we decided to join Rotary. Since my Rotary Club of Parwanoo would not let me leave that club under any circumstances, we decided that Kanan take-up membership of RC Chandigarh Midtown, where we already had many friends. After attending some meetings of your club, I started to enjoy and take interest in many projects. When Kanan took over as the President I became fully involved in various projects and we enjoyed working together.

May both of you keep igniting the spirit Rotary
