Rotary Club Chandigarh Horizon, in collaboration with Rotary Club Chandigarh Midtown, successfully organised a Menstrual Hygiene & Health Awareness Session for girl students at GMSSS, Sector 35-D, Chandigarh. The programme aimed to create awareness about menstrual hygiene, dispel myths, and encourage young girls to adopt healthy hygiene practices with confidence and dignity.

The programme commenced with a warm welcome by Rtn Avinash Taneja, President, Rotary Club Chandigarh Horizon, who welcomed the faculty, students, resource person, and Rotarians. He highlighted Rotary's commitment to women's health, education, and community service and encouraged the students to seek accurate information without hesitation.
