MOHALI - THE NEW DISTRICT OF CHANDIGARH TRICITY

Our club meeting on Nov. 3, 2006 had more than a 'House Full' attendance. In addition to a good number of our own members, there were Presidents & Members of Rotary Club Mohali and the Industrial Association, Mohali. To tell us about the plans & opportunities in Mohali, the new district of the Chandigarh Tricity, we had none other than its first Deputy Commissioner, Mr. Tejveer Singh, IAS. He was introduced to the gathering by Secy. Rtn. R.K. Luther.

Mr. Tejveer Singh gave an interesting talk based on the facts & figures regarding Mohali's development as a District. Mohali came up in 1970s. It was earlier planned as an industrial township, gradually going towards housing as well. The years through 1980s & early 1990s were not so good for Mohali due to terrorism. This resulted in setback for development of Mohali, and steep progress for Panchkula township of the Chandigarh Tricity. Panchkula transformed into a district much earlier.

Mohali came up as a district in April 2006. Mohali residents were dependent on District Ropar, even for traffic challans. It was a city for two-wheelers. Now there are many more cars. Mohali is also attracting large scale real estate business.

Employment opportunities have increased. There is a boost in the economy. There is a provision of Rs. 8 crore for improving the facilities in the civil hospital. A bio-tech park is also being planned. In addition to the existing landmarks like the world class cricket stadium, Niper, Fortis Institute & Silver Oaks hospital, many more national level organisations are coming up in Mohali. Medical facilities are being developed not only as curative but preventive as well. Railway connectivity is going to be available to other parts of Punjab from the upcoming Mohali station.

Mohali is having 436 villages. Dera Bassi & Zirakpur also form part of Mohali District. Growth in these towns is in an unplanned manner. But as a District, Mohali would have its own identity. There is ample public support. Also, there have to be vibrant cultural activities. Mohali is being planned to give good life on all fronts. A city centre is also being planned by the govt. Mohali will undergo very large transformation in a couple of years.

Chandigarh having become saturated, Mohali has tremendous scope for growth. Chandigarh Airport is heading for expansion and this will take place towards Mohali. Chandigarh has its limitations whereas Mohali has a lot of potential. On social front also, an Old Age Home, a Drug De-addiction Centre and a Red Cross building is also in the

PPI 2006 - MARCH TOWARDS POLIO ERADICATION

An appeal by President Dr.V.J.S.Vohra

Polio has not been fully eliminated from India. Let us all assemble on 12th November, 2006 at 9 AM at the Aanganwadi Centre, Sector 24, Chandigarh (on dividing road of sectors 23 & 24) and undertake to eradicate this dreadful disease from our country. Club meeting of Friday has been postponed for this purpose.

Rotary is part of a global partnership that, since 1988, has reduced the number of polio cases worldwide by 99 percent. Despite tremendous progress in reducing the incidence of polio, it still exists. Polio will continue to threaten children everywhere as long as it exists somewhere. Polio is a highly infectious disease that primarily affects children under the age of three and can cause paralysis within hours. Before eradication efforts began in 1988, polio paralyzed more than 1000 children a day, which totalled about 350,000 children annually. Vaccinations easily can stave off polio. Vaccinations have prevented an estimated 500,000 children per year from contracting polio.

Only four countries are still polio endemic an all-time low : Nigeria, India, Pakistan, and Afghanistan. Rotary International is the spearheading member of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative and is the largest private sector donor. It has contributed more than US\$ 600 million to the

polio eradication activities in 122 countries. A polio-free world is within our grasp.

In his message for November 2006, RI President Bill Boyd said, "The cost of a dose of oral polio vaccine is small, but the logistics of delivering it are daunting. Yet when hundreds or thousands of Rotarians come together to deliver vaccines during a National Immunization Day, the greatest hurdle has already been overcome, and the Foundation is there to help with the rest. Great works like these could not happen without Rotarians"

Rotary Chandigarh Midtown has been associated with the Polio Booths at Sectors 11, 14, 15, 23, 24, 25, Dadumajra, Dhanas and Sarangpur. All Rotarians & R'anns are requested to "Lead The Way" with a march towards polio eradication by joining Rotary's effort to end this crippling disease. We have to ensure that our commitment towards this noble cause is fulfilled by devoting a few hours on Sunday Nov. 12, 2006.
