

Open House Discussion on Death Penalty

After the declaration of the board of 2007-08, President Dr. Vohra invited PP Dr. Balram Gupta, a Senior Advocate, to lead the Open House discussion on Death Penalty. There is a

persistent trend internationally to abolish the death penalty but India is among the countries that retain it and although India still practices capital punishment, it is rarely used.

A 1983 ruling by the Supreme Court stated that the death penalty should be imposed only in "the rarest of rare cases". Since this is not further defined and no clear guidelines exist, the use of death penalty is largely dependant on the interpretation of this phrase by individual judges. Dr. Balram clarified that in certain cases death penalty has been justified, though it is a very sensitive issue for the court to order a capital punishment. Various factors are taken into account before pronouncing a death penalty or a life imprisonment.

Only particularly gruesome or politically sensitive cases have attracted the penalty. The assassins of India's independence leader, Mahatma Gandhi, and former Prime Minister Indira Gandhi were among those executed in the past 60 years.

In India the death penalty is carried out by hanging. An attempt to challenge this method of execution failed in the Supreme Court, which stated in its 1983 judgment that hanging did not involve torture, barbarity, humiliation or degradation.

There was even a suggestion for public hanging. At this juncture, Rtn. Arjan Singh expressed his dissent. Ann Indu Luthra was in favour of capital punishment. "Nobody has a right to take the life of any person and if someone does, he has no right to stay alive himself", she said. PP Rtn Dr. Kesho Ram Gupta suggested that murder cannot be compensated with another murder. Rtn. Gurdip Deep was also not in favour of death penalty, neither was Ann Lovy Peter. She said that life imprisonment should literally mean for full life. There should be no parole release after 7 years or 14 years. Rtn. RaviTulsi was also not in favour of capital punishment.

Rtn. Atul Grover took a philosophical stand saying that a murderer should be given full life imprisonment. He talked about karmas and said that in case the convict is eliminated with a death penalty, he will take re-birth and would continue his killing instinct even in the next life!

There were more discussions to follow on the topic but for lack of time, the meeting had to be adjourned. If any member would like to give his / her comments on the subject it would be welcome and would find a place in the bulletin.
