The Chariot Moves



On Magha 1, 2063 of the Vikram Samvat, translated as Sunday, January 14, 2007 of the Christian era, designated as "Makar Sankranti", two events occurred which must have brought gladness to hearts of the Malayalee speaking people. It must be acknowledged that the attention to detail of President Kapil Gupta and his team, counseled by the experienced Past District Governor Subhash Garg, and, District Governor Nominee Satish Saluja, now dubbed "the patriarch", was beyond compare. The occasion was more like

a marriage function, with the flower bedecked horse drawn *buggy, the dhol, the bhanga*, et al. Feel it from the photographs. The timing of the entire function, as well as its presentation was perfect. They say, the way to a man's heart, is through his stomach. The menu, and the food, was delightfully delicious.

Speaking on the occasion, in his own grandiose manner, Raja Saboo, Past Rotary International President, acknowledged the focus of dedication to responsibility of Shaju, based on his recent experience at the Zone Institute. An analytical mind, and incisive execution of the translated task, was his hallmark. He warned Rotarians that during his year, non-performance would not be accepted. The time was short, and the tasks challenging.

Incoming Chairperson of Inner Wheel District 308 Samira Saluja, made an excellent presentation while introducing Shaju and Lovy. In fact, she showcased several unknown facets of Shaju and Lovy, quite to the amazement of the audience, including their first meeting, which, till now was known only to a close limited few.

Emotional "Bon Voyage" to Lovy and Shaju

A packed Sheesh Mahal, has always been an indicator of either an interesting function, or, of a fellowship. On Friday, January 12, 2007, it was for both. Quite interestingly, no one grumbled that the meeting began almost an hour late! And everyone was willing to await the arrival of the giants of the Club to bid "Bon Voyage" to the first District Governor Elect from Chandigarh Midtown in 30 years.

By the time the meeting began, following the "coffee and cake" ritual, there was a palpable change in atmosphere from bonhomie to emotional.



When Shaju and Lovy took their seat on the dais, his ringing laughter seemed to have faded a perceptible shade, and, in its place, was a serious look. It appeared that he was feeling embarrassed at the prospect of facing the club now as District Governor, than a simple active Past President. Humbleness is the hallmark of this couple.

BLR - "The Guru", introduced Shaju statistically, listing his personal and Rotary achievements chronologically. He struck an emotional chord, when, he described how Shaju, still not a Rotarian, went beyond his duty, to help a bereaved Rotarian, which led to his being proposed and inducted into Rotary by none other than his friend, and one time Secretary of this Club, Chander Mohan Khera. Chander, is Past President of Wallaton Park Rotary, Nottingham, with which we have established sister club relationship.



Suraj Handa, the Club's "Service Above Self" Awardee and a Charter member, now an Honorary Rotarian, was his deeply emotional self, while speaking in his now panting voice. Shaju and Suraj were neighbors, when Shaju first came to Chandigarh. Naturally, he had fond memories of their association.

Indrajeet, inducted into the Club during Shaju's tenure as President, looks up to him as his mentor, is a personal friend, and addresses him as "chief", spoke with great fondness of his family's visit to Shaju's village. He recalled his meeting with Shaju's mother, fondly addressed as "Ammachi", and spoke of his transformation from a "leader in his profession" to a "leader of humanity".
