CYBER CRIME & PHONE TAP

The guest speaker for the club meeting last Friday, March 29, 2007, Prof. Ms. Divya Bansal, M.Tech was introduced by PP Pallav Mukherjee. She is a Lecturer in Department of Computer Science & Engineering, Punjab Engineering College, Chandigarh. Ms. Divya is part of the team to conduct specialist research in the areas of information and cyber security through Cyber Security Research Centre, the first of its kind in the country, set up in Chandigarh to deal with issues like data protection, confidentiality & data privacy. The centre has been recently set up by the Chandigarh Administration in collaboration with National Association of Software & Service Companies (NASSCOM) and the Punjab Engineering College. The need for a Cyber Security Research Centre here was felt as there was speedy growth of the IT sector in the region. The research centre will handle personal, confidential & sensitive data and create a sense of comfort & security among IT companies. Research at the centre would help upgrade cyber security in IT companies and enhance the credibility and reputation of the Indian IT sector.

While narrating how Rtn. B.B. Bahl became a victim of cyber crime recently as \$ 6000 has been swiped on his credit card in Romania, whereas he has not traveled abroad for the last over one year, Ms. Divya Bansal talked about a small hand-held device known as skimmer. It could be a waiter or a store clerk or attendant of a petrol pump or anyone you've handed your credit card to for payment. Instead of just charging your card, an extra swipe of your credit card could be done into the skimmer. This cheap device, costing just a few hundred rupees, takes the data from your card, giving the miscreant all the information needed to make a counterfeit card. Credit card skimming has become a worldwide problem. Once the information has been downloaded into a skimmer, it can be downloaded into a computer and e-mailed anywhere in the world.

Indian Penal Code covers many cyber crimes, such as e-mail spoofing and cyber defamation, sending threatening e-mails, etc. A simple yet sturdy definition of cyber crime would be

Computers and internet have become an important & effective mode of studying, doing business or running any office or establishment. Awareness is required to safeguard your data, whether it is credit card, your mobile phone, e-mail or internet. You should not give your personal details on the phone or respond to do so by e-mail. Ms. Divya said that in USA, the call centers sell the data for \$ 5 each. Do not send your details through email without verifying the credentials of the other party. Beware! Cyber Criminals are on the prowl. There are duplicate websites floated by the hackers. Do not pass on your data to dubious mails & sites.

Recently a young girl was about to be married to a boy she liked. One day the boy looked worried and upset. He told her that, members of his family had been receiving e-mails that contained malicious things about the girl's character. He told her that his parents were very upset and were considering breaking off the engagement. The boy prevailed upon his parents and the matter was reported to the police. During investigation, it was revealed that the person sending those e-mails was the girl's step-father. He had sent these e-mails to break up the marriage, which would have caused him to lose control of her property of which he was the guardian till she got married.

While talking about phone tap, Ms. Divya said that mobile phones have become a big network in India. Data goes by air and can easily be tapped. Surveillance through the interception of messages and conversations may be necessary under certain circumstances, especially when terrorism is a live threat. The Indian Telegraph Act, 1885 gives the Centre and State Governments the power to intercept any message in case of a "public emergency" or "in the interest of public safety." It was to prevent the arbitrary exercise of this power that the Supreme Court framed guidelines in 1996 to regulate such surveillance. Observing that illegal phone tapping was "a serious violation of individual privacy," the Court laid down certain conditions. There is tremendous expansion of mobile phone services & use, and entry of a number of private players into the telecom sector. It is necessary to review the 1996 safeguards rigorously, from the standpoint of citizens' rights. There must be a serious attempt to tighten the regulations that govern the tapping of telephones and crack down on violations of the citizen's right to privacy.

There was a query from PP Col. A.J.S. Gill regarding use of yahoo etc. for emails, to which the Guest Speaker suggested the use of Outlook Express. Rtn. Atul Grover while proposing vote of thanks, suggested the use of modern technology with precautions against virus & other pitfalls.

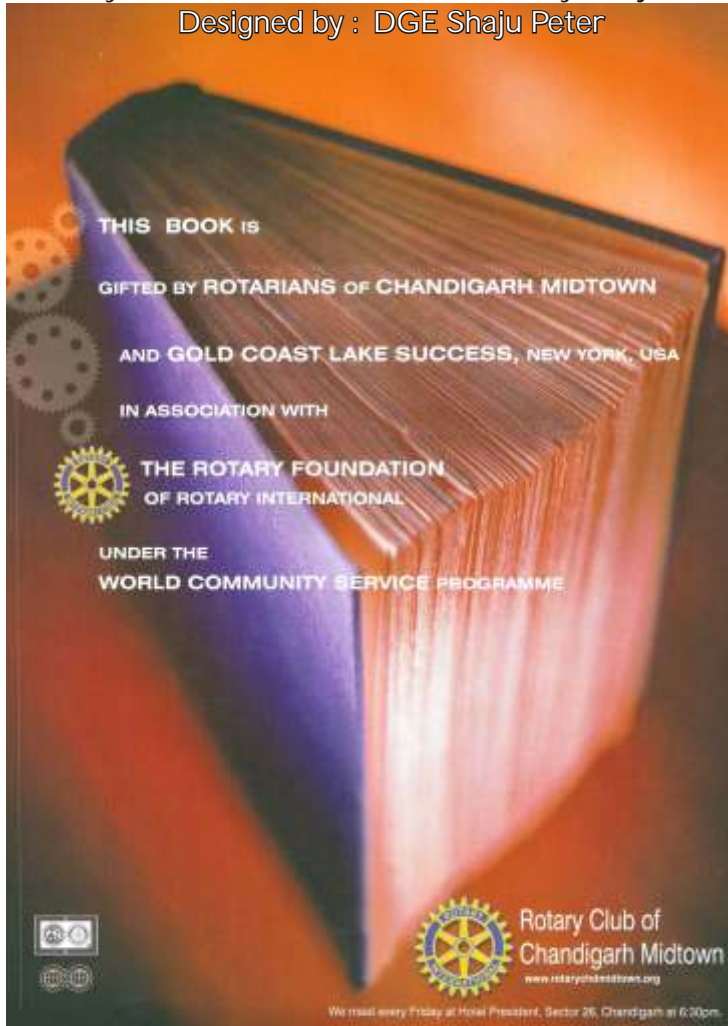
