
President (2006-07) Dr. Vohra explained the service and fellowship activities of the Club in the year 2006-07. He emphasized the projects to help the challenged children


Past President of Association of Inner Wheel Clubs in India, Rtn Anuradha Kalra, in her thanksgiving and



She said that Mr Dua is an old friend of the Club and he was an Honorary Member of our Club in the year 2005-06 when PP Rtn RK Goyal was the President of the Club. She described him as a very forthright media personality but with a broad and friendly smile always on his face. Dr. Vanita credited Mr Dua for bringing credibility into the news. She profusely thanked him for joining the meeting of the Club and said that it is always educative and a pleasure to listen to Mr. Dua.

Mr HK Dua Editor-in-Chief The Tribune, addressed the meeting in a very relaxed manner and removed all the stresses and strains of the Installation proceedings. He thanked Dr. Vanita Gupta for introducing him and saying all the good words about him. He eulogized Dr. Farooq Abdullah for his commitment and untiring efforts to solve the various tricky issues facing us. He said that if our

Governments had listened to him when he was the Chief Minister J & K, all the current problems facing the state would not be there.

A BIG Thank You and Invitation for Dinner by the President

The Editor-in-Chief advised that the Rotary should plant more trees and include the girl-child in their literacy programmes.

Rtn Deepa Bhar was to introduce the Chief Guest Dr Farooq Abdullah and she prepared for it in Urdu language with Urdu couplets composed by her. But due to the constraints of time available to the Chief Guest, this part of the evening's programme was skipped. Therefore the President requested Dr Farooq Abdullah to address the Midtowners and the guests.

Be a Bharti(Indian) First and Remove The Divide between People

Dr Farooq Abdullah started his address with a very vivid description of his adventurous and frightening air journey from Sirinagar to Chandigarh due to the very inclement weather that also caused a big delay by a few hours before his flight touched down at Chandigarh. The plane hit an air pocket en-route that caused a sudden loss of altitude and even the airhostess shrieked, but all heaved a sigh of relief when the plane touched down at the Chandigarh airport.

He talked about truth that it is bitter and it causes troubles in the present set up of the world but with Allah's grace truth always prevails. He appreciated the Club's achievements and plans for service to the community as spelt out by IPP Rtn Dr VJS Vohra and President Sandeep Sandhu. He also appreciated the role of Rotary in the world on eradicating polio and particularly in India during the floods in Andhra Pradesh. Generally people are ready to give for a cause but they are afraid whether what they give, will reach where it is needed or will it be pocketed en-route. He advised the Club to donate medical equipments to the hospitals as they are generally short of critical equipments. Dr Abdullah cited an example of giving and its outcome. He said that out of the grants available to him, he released Rs, 30 lac to a hospital in J & K to buy a critical piece of medical equipment. Eight months there after the equipment has not arrived because the private doctor's influence who own this type of equipment in their clinics and are afraid of loss of business if the hospital gets the equipment and the greed and corruption of those who are responsible to procure the equipment.

The Chief Guest wondered whether he would see the India dreamt by the leaders and people of the years after independence. That dream has eluded us. There is poverty and hunger and hatred and enmity, which is

seeping into the thoughts of us Indians and is pulling the country to strife. Let us all work to stop this rot, let us not brand communities on the actions of a few, and let us not put hatred amongst people. Religions do not divide people, they teach the followers to be an "Insaan" first. The esteemed Leader spoke from his heart when he said that let us Be Bharti First and remove the Divide between People whether it is the economic divide or the religious divide. All faiths lead to the same goal, so why this Divide, he asked. He further advised that when Rotary goes to schools, it should spread the spirit of Indian ness, tolerance and a corruption-free India.

Dr Farooq emphasized that India wants peace with all our neighbors and the world. He quoted the present Prime Minister who said that let us make the L of C the line of peace and that borders cannot be changed but they can be made irrelevant. He also quoted the erstwhile Prime Minister Bajpai who, at the time of the Indian nuclear test, said that the test was not a show of strength for aggression but a show that we can defend ourselves.

India does not want to capture territory, he explained, and cited the examples of our military help to Bangladesh, Maldives and Sri Lanka. We want peace, we want a prosperous and happy India and let us all work for that.

The address was received with a thumping bout of prolonged applause.

The Chief Guest left for Delhi immediately after his address as he was scheduled to reach Sirinagar in the morning.
