and Chandigarh Midtown Milano Sud-Est have helped a large number of unemployed people to become self employed in a worthy trade and earn an honest living.

PP Rtn. Kesho Ram Gupta has been handling the Bharat Gupta Milano Fierra project since its inception in 2000. This loan has helped

168 beneficiaries. Kesho Ram Gupta explained how the name of the project was coined. Our clubs contribution to the project amount was, a donation from the Gupta family, dedicated to the memory of their son, Bharat, a bright engineer who had always helped people in need. Rtn. K. R. Gupta touched the heart of the audience when he cited some of the many success stories of the beneficiaries. In-spite of two defaulters, the corpus of Rs. 4,30,000/- stands intact, courtesy Rtn. K.R. Gupta and is in fact Rs. 5000/- richer. The figure today stands as Rs. 4,35,000/-





Revolving Loan Funds


Revolving Loans, also called microcredit or village banking, are projects that organize low-income persons, usually women, to borrow money, animals, or equipment to facilitate small economic self-help enterprises. The funds continue to revolve; funds are loaned to beneficiaries, repaid and loaned again, hopefully in perpetuity.

Grant funds may be used for revolving loan capital for up to US\$10,000 per credit group. One grant may support multiple credit groups. Also called a village bank, a credit group is a group of 10 to 30 borrowers, usually women, organized, educated, and trained in the rudiments of saving, credit, and entrepreneurship, who cross-guarantee each others' loans to ensure repayment to the fund.


All Revolving Loan Fund grant applications will undergo an initial review by a member of the Humanitarian Programs Cadre of Technical Advisors.


