Come the 5th September, & we are in for a major event ! We are having the Mayor of the City, accompanied by his colleagues – the Sr. Dy. Mayor Mrs. Anju Beniwal & the Dy. Mayor Mr. H.S. Kalyan, over for an interactive session with us.

Maybe this is the day that can mark a new beginning of something for the city.

First a bit of history.

It was in the year 1992 that our Parliament enacted a momentous bit of legislation. These two legislations are the 73rd & the 74th Amendments. And they are designed to give power to the people.

Let's face facts – you don't know !

These two amendments were a pretty good idea. We originally had a simple system of governance – the Prime Minister & his colleagues looked after the country while the Chief Ministers & their coteries looked after their interest in the States.

The problem was that if your area did not fall in the CM's constituency or one of the powerful ruling party MLAs, you hardly got any development.

Now to address this basic anomaly in the development process, these two amendments became a life saver ! The 73rd Amendment addresses the PRIs (Panchayati Raj Institutions) while the 74th takes care of the ULBs (Urban Local Bodies).

And suddenly these PRIs or ULBs became a hot seat for power. Political parties jumped into the fray and the next thing you know is that political bosses were dictating – to their minions in the local bodies – how, what & where to spend some of those massive funds that ended up in the towns & cities.

All of which brings us back to the first postulate – do you know how public funds are being spent in your

village, town or city ? Or are you content with the MC buying useless equipment at ten times the actual cost, or executing projects which never see the light of the day....the list can only start, never end !

So can we expect you at this Friday's meeting ?
