

The Great Banking Crisis

What happens is that a bunch of industries manufacturing this & that, get together their lobbyists to convince their politicians to pressurise their banks to lower their lending rates. When this happens, it's but natural that people will get cheaper loans to buy that TV they do not need, or that extra car in the driveway. There's a world full of glib talking salesmen & marketing professionals out there.

So you have increased consumption, leading to increased demand & concomitant purchase, leading to more money supply & disposable income, leading to more

cars on the street, shops to sell them from & high-rise flats for people to start new nuclear families. There is a tremendous demand for infra-structure, leading to developmental bonds, or infra-structure funds – all of which is then called growth. And the wily politician takes the credit for it! Not knowing that the artificial pumping in of money is not backed by real assets.

So what happens when someone calls the bluff? Like realises that the lower interest rates in the banks aren't really bringing in the moolah – what with Lehman Bros. paying annual salaries of almost a crore to fresh incumbents from B-schools!

In the Great Depression of the early thirties, there were more than twenty five thousand banks in the US! More than ten thousand of them went belly up after the great stock market crash of 1929. This year, about fifteen banks have failed in the US. My guess is they are down to maybe eight thousand or so today.

This is unlike India, with its hundred banks. They are all tightly controlled by the RBI. So much so that almost 40% of their capital is actually locked up in

government securities. The CRR is a shade under 10%, which basically means that your money is safe. The other thing is that although we have a huge stock market in operation today, there's a limited input in Investment Banks. Most people still put their money into savings accounts or FDs in the bank around the corner, rather than in the stock market, or in private placements with suave investment bankers or brokers.

Also, the loan rates are high – maybe the highest in the world! The loan shark in the villages may have disappeared, but the anathema to taking a loan is still there in most of us. We hate to live on credit, as most credit card companies will ruefully tell you. It is only now with globalization that diverse financial instruments have come to our lives, or grown to be part of the world economy scene.

So even if our stocks sink, our money in the banks are safe because they won't come under. And we do not put much faith in rating companies who seem to be giving A+++ to all & sundry. Most American assets held by US banks have done so at an over-valuation of

He made all of us present there, including all the hundred plus blind children, and their teachers, other staff & blind guests, feel part of an extraordinary team that can, & has redeemed, the faith of many in human kindness. I loved the way he spurred the children to overcome daily obstacles & gain strength from winning these seemingly insurmountable problems.

Maj. Gen. Rajendra Nath has dedicated his life to the cause of the Blind. He's been at the helm of the affairs - and the extraordinary growth of the Institute for the Blind here in Chandigarh - for

almost a quarter of a century now ! We had the Mayor of the City, Pradeep Chhabra, accompanied by his wife, as the Chief Guest. He has been associated with the Blind School before as well. In fact, only less than a month ago, he celebrated his birthday with the children of the Blind School. He has promised them a Sensory Garden, named after Louis Braille, the founder of the unique language for the blind worldwide.
