### Cancer Awareness – The Pink October

Last Friday, the Oct. 24th was United Nations Day – and it has something to do with Chandigarh - no, not in any way that you are thinking! Don't worry (we Indians never do !), but one in every twenty three women will get cancer - Breast Cancer every six & a half minutes ! Admitted that you are a pampered citizen – you get clean water piped right into your homes, an efficient sewerage system, a reasonably good garbage collection system, clean & verdant surrounds complete with parks, & wide roads & berms – but you are not in the majority ; in fact you are one of the miniscule minority, within this city itself, privy to such luxuries as air-conditioned homes, with air-conditioned cars to drive to airconditioned supermarkets, but rest assured, the air you breathe is the same - as are the foods that you buy & the water that you drink.

The environment will affect you - like it or not! You are never isolated. So you never know when, where, why & how cancer strikes, when some airborne virus will enter your body & trigger those irreversible changes that cause the cells to self-destruct, or mutate, to cancerous cells!

In the locker room the coach, perplexed, asked, "Son, what happened ?" The player said. "My father was blind. Only today he witnessed my game."


Motivation provides stimulus. He believed that his father would see his game after his death. This belief motivated him to play exceedingly well!

## Artificial Limbs Project

A camp for fitment of artificial limbs was held on 20th Oct., 2008 at Cheshire Homes India, Sector 21, Chandigarh. The camp was conducted under the supervision of President Saroj Jhawar and Rtn. Maj. Gen. A.S. Kahlon, Chairman, Cheshire Homes Chandigarh.

This project would be implemented by Jyot Charitable Trust through Prosthetic Consultant PP Dr. V.J.S. Vohra, CEO Nevedac Prosthetic Clinic, assisted by his professional team, who took the plaster casts & measurements of the patients, including the inmates of Cheshire Home. To motivate the disabled persons we also had Rtn. Om Prakash and Office Secy. V.P. Sharma. Rtn. Deepak Sood celebrated his birthday with the disabled

persons by donating one meal of the day for the inmates of Cheshire Home. Soon to be Rotarian Amariit Singh donated sweets and being a computer professional, he also offered to train the disabled persons.

This being a joint project with Rotary Club of Wollaton Park (UK), the distribution of artificial limbs will be done in mid Nov. 2008 when members from the UK club are expected to be in Chandigarh. PP Rtn. Mohan Khera had initiated this project in which over 20 disabled persons are expected to be fitted with artificial limbs and assistive devices.
