Pulse Polio Campaign - In The Last Push

Since the Pulse Polio NIDs were to be held from Sunday, Feb. 1, '09 till Feb. 3, '09, there could'nt have been a better time for PDG J.P.S. Sibia, Chairman - Polio Plus Committee, RID 3080, to visit our Club last Friday and deliver a motivational talk about the subject to us Rotarians.

While introducing PDG Sibia, PP Capt. Moni Kahlon spoke about his academic, professional as well as Rotary achievements. He described him as very learned PDG who will be representing our Distt. 3080 at the Council of Legislation in USA next year.

At present the world is in favor of eradication of polio because the epidemiology and the transmission cycle of the disease make it amenable to eradication. Polio usually strikes children under the age of five. It can cripple the spinal cord and brain, causing paralysis and even death. It is transmitted through food or water contaminated by the faecal matter of an infected person.

But polio cannot be battled only on the medical front. It includes psychological support for the victim from his/her family and from a society where many look down upon patients.

PDG Sibia brought forth the fact that since this dreaded virus was in its final stages, an element of



complacency or "fatigue" seemed to have set in our minds. Complacency, because we are quite near to our objective of eradicating polio from India & fatigue, because of the fact that our efforts as a nation to eradicate polio, have been on since 1988. So there is a strong need for determination & a renewed commitment towards the cause.

Many of us remain focussed only on our localities where we might not have come across any case of polio, and so one hardly takes any initiative to explore other areas where cases of polio or even its awareness might not be reaching. We Rotarians must get the word out that if we don't eradicate polio now, the risk of deadly and crippling polio outbreaks will continue to threaten the world's children.

Secondly, although the NID booths are installed at most of the places ensuring almost 100% coverage, there are places like bus stand, railway station & construction sites where one can find a lot many children of porters, labourers, etc. to whom the polio vaccine may not have reached. So we Rotarians can identify such localities around us and thus, be a local guide for the teams of workers who go from house to house to look for children who missed the Pulse Polio dose on the previous National Immunization days. Rotarians can also play an important role in working with health workers, pediatricians and others to find, report and investigate cases of acute flaccid paralysis in timely manner (ideally within 48 hours of its onset)

Another important aspect of the Polio Eradication programme emphasised by the learned speaker is to spread as much awareness about it as one can. The biggest challenge is to dispel misconceptions and misunderstandings related to the oral polio vaccine in the poor communities, which ultimately results into repeated refusal of parents to let their children be administered the dosage. They feel that the vaccine may do some harm or make their children ill. Rotarians should, therefore, actively involve

themselves with health workers for educating & spreading the word that :

- Even sick and newborn children are to be given Polio drops. These drops are in addition to routine immunization doses.
- These drops are completely safe and are of highest quality.
- Repeated doses provide additional protection.
- Routine polio vaccination at birth, 6 weeks, 10 weeks and 14 weeks of age is also essential.

Also, if any of the non - Rotarians have been involved in polio eradication efforts such as NIDs or have had personal experiences with the disease, they must be invited to speak at the Clubs. After hearing a firsthand account, many people will understand the threat the wild poliovirus still poses to children in certain areas of the world.

The voluntary efforts made by us may be a vital factor in ensuring the success of the Polio Eradication Program. If we commit ourselves to reach every child, polio will soon be history.


