Make Dreams Real – Build a Shelter

Fertile brains germinate ideas. Tender hearts help translate them to reality.

When our Charter President Dr. B.D. Gupta's opinion was sought on the possibility of a meaningful project, he was quick to grasp the opportunity to suggest the "Shelter Project" at Sector 32 Government Medical College and Hospital. The idea appealed to our Club Leaders, who after an on site reconnaissance, found it to be meaningful. The plight of the patients and their attendants was indeed heart-breaking.

Sitting out in the open, either in the scorching sun or extreme winter, rain and shine, with their patients, without access to clean drinking water or toilets, is, to put it mildly, most inconvenient.

Thus began an ambitious Club Project. PP R.S. Chandgothia, accompanied Dr. B.D. Gupta all the way to St. Stephens Hospital, Delhi, where a similar shelter had been constructed. A tête-à-tête with the visitors was inspiring. They appreciated the concern, not only of the Hospital, but also the kind-hearted people who donated the shelter there.

On their return, and with the good offices of Dr. B.D. Gupta, a meeting with the Director-Principal Dr. Raj Bahadur was set up. He was very impressed with the idea, and immediately agreed to it. A Government-Rotary Co-operative Project is not the easiest to initiate. Mandatory sanctions, require piles of documentation. On the Club's part the initial activity of creating acceptable detailed drawings began. Modifications to suit the architectural department's requirements were made. Once cleared, it required the administration's clearance. To & fro paper-pushing, constant

follow-ups and naturally, building up a good PR, were an integral part of the exercise.

Finally, the official letter arrived. So impressed were the administrators of the St. Stephens' Shelter photographs, that they defined the shelter

Fine, said the committee. In fact, there was no other option.

Then began the most difficult effort of Finances. Over past two months, while the demarcation of the site was in progress concurrently, some kind-hearted Rotarians and Citizens of Chandigarh, donated generously, bringing in some funds, though not sufficient enough – Rs. 2.5 Lakhs against a projected



estimate of Rs. 15 Lakhs.

All good deeds attract good Samaritans. When the project was explained to R.K. Luther, he too was impressed. The search began. R.K. Luther is a man of action. Within 24 hours, he set up a meeting between the club's Committee and Mr. Jivan Agarwal of Amravati Builders. Mr. Agarwal is a kind-hearted God-fearing man. He quickly agreed to donate the entire steel structure, designed by Bachtar Singh, Past President of Rotary Central. He provided his services free-

of-cost.

This lifted the spirit, and civil works began a fortnight ago. Obviously, we have a long way to go, merely because of restraints of funding. You could either contribute through the souvenir being brought out on the occasion, or you could donate in kind to finance the project. Quite a novel idea! In any case, the largesse of Midtowners is well known. Do what you would like to, but go ahead and contribute.
