He has been a member of the Punjab Legislative Assembly continuously since 1995, and currently serves as the Finance, Planning and Program Implementation Minister, Punjab. He has remained the Chairman of the Public Accounts Committee for a 5-year term, was a member of the senate of Punjab University, Chandigarh; Syndic of Punjabi University, Patiala; and has been a member of the Punjab State

Education Board.



A Basketball player, he has captained his school team, received full colors from his college, and represented Punjab State in the Nationals in Goa in 1981.

An ardent follower of Military history, particularly, British Indian Army History, leading to the Partition of India, he is also a keen reader of social and economic philosophers and developmental economics of third world countries.

He is a tireless social activist for the elimination of cancer in the Malwa Region, through the supply of safe drinking water, and environment friendly farming practices. He is a crusader for the spread of education.

He is un-orthodox. He is the only Minister of the Punjab Cabinet who receives a token honorarium as a Legislator and Minister, drives his own car and refuses security cover.

Married to Vinu he has a son and a daughter.

Rotary Year's First Micro Credit Disbursed

During his visit to Italy as District Governor in 2007-08, Shaju Peter, to seek Project collaboration, his batch mates of all 10 districts approached their respective Clubs not to present them bouquets during their official visits, and instead donate the equivalent value towards the corpus of a Micro Credit project! With addition to this corpus by our own Club, and a Matching Grant from the Rotary Foundation, a Revolving Micro Credit project, not dissimilar from the Gramin Bank Project of Bangladesh conceptualized and initiated by Nobel Laureate

Dr. Mohammad Yunus, Head of the Rural Economics Program at the University of Chittagong, was designed to provide credit for the poor.

This was after the un-mitigated success of the earlier Chandigarh Midtown Milano Sud Est Revolving Micro Credit World Community Service Matching Grant project initiated by Lakshmi Khanna of the Milan Club and our Club during 1996-97 when Col. Amar Jit Singh Gill was the President.

Energy and Environment-Is Doomsday Near?

Introduction of Assistant Governor Prof S.K.Sharma is a voluminous task. He is exceptionally talented and distinctively rare person. Holding a Ph. D. in Chemical Engineering, he has remained a Professor of Chemical Engineering, and Director

of the Energy Research Center. A Ford Foundation Fellow, an US AID Fellow, he is recipient of numerous national and international Awards. He has served as Commonwealth Expert and Consultant, UNICEF expert to many countries. He was Chairperson of GOI's Working Group on Renewable Energy, and a National Advisor of Alternate Energy. He has to his credit more than 100 research papers. He was handpicked by Dr. Manmohan Singh to serve on the NSA. Vinod Sobti introduced him.

Human development is a direct function of per capita energy consumption. Energy is also an indicator of economic growth and poverty alleviation. With India aspiring to be a super power its per capita energy consumption is woefully low. Less than 50 percent of Indian population has access to commercial energy sources like electricity and gas. More than 800 million people depend on bio mass fuel like cow dung, wood and other residues to meet their energy needs, exposing them to carcogenic pollutants. This is a mojor cause of mortality and morbidity in rural women and children. This is confirmed by WHO statistics.

Therefore, there is complete distortion in the commercial use of energy resources in the country. Twenty percent of the India's population uses 80 percent of its energy resources.

To this distortion has been added a new dimension of global warming, which has emerged as the greatest threat to the human race. In case the present trend continues, the earth's temperature will increase dramatically by three degrees,

resulting in Arctic Ice melt, consequentially increasing sea level, and displacement of several million people in coastal areas, submerging half a million hectares of land, and effect the breeding and migration of fish. Widespread disease is expected.

It is estimated that every 2.5 degree of global temperature rise, will lower rice yield by 20 to 50 percent, wheat yield by 25 to 60 percent, and loss of 1.5 million tons of milk in India alone. Disruption due to draughts and floods will impact economy.

In conclusion, Prof. Sharma emphasized the duty of every citizen to reduce commercial energy consumption, including electricity, gases, petrol, diesel, use energy-efficient appliance at home, and machinery in our workplace, adding greatly the use of renewable energy sources like solar energy, not only to correct the existing imbalance, but also to reduce climate change. Wasteful use of water, like in car washing should be avoided.

These are issues, he said, must be addressed and actively propagated by Rotarians, and responsible leaders of society.

Vinod Kumar Jawa, proposed a formal vote of thanks and also bagged this weeks' punctuality draw.
