Alcohol - Facts and Myth

In the club meeting on April 27, 2012 Guest Speaker Mrs. Ravneet Kaur, Sr. Lecturer, Guru Gobind Singh College of Pharmacy, Chandigarh was introduced by President R.K. Luther. She has done M.Pharm and Research in Standardization of Herbal Drugs from Panjab University. She is also Vice President of NGO, The Support for poor school children, and running a Library, holding a stock of over 3000 books of all religions, at Nanaksar Gurdwara, Sector 28, Chandigarh.

Ravneet said, "I will not say whether people should have alcohol or not, but what I want to say is 'know your drink'." She recalled a recent incident, reported in local

newspaper, of two school girls consuming over dose of alcohol, were taken from a public place to the hospital, and then their parents were summoned.

Ravneet's concern was the youth, the children of today. She

talked about moral science, which is today missing in the class room!

Through power point presentation she explained that the human brain does not fully develop until the early 20's. Alcohol use before that drastically impacts learning and memory. She pointed out "80% of students drink. 71% of students drink once a week or less. Half of these students drink once a month or less. Approximately 600,000 students per year are assaulted by drinking students."

The teens drink to escape pressure or problems, to feel better or to overcome being sad or lonely, to deal with stress and relax, to feel more self-confident in social situations, for excitement, to deal with boredom or because their friends are doing it. Factors that affect the teens to use alcohol are due to pressure, parents using it to solve their problems/stress and the misleading advertisements.

Ravneet described alcohol as Ethyl alcohol or ethanol, produced by fermentation of yeast, sugars and starches. It is a psychoactive drug, and it is a central nervous system depressant. Therefore, it can have a negative impact on school-work, athletics, friendships, family, relationships and career goals.

She said, "Parents should find time for their children and guide them properly. The youth needs to be protected against the wild culture of our city."

Ravneet cautioned, "No medical condition, other than heart disease, causes more disability and premature death than alcohol-related problems." She explained how it attacks the brain and affects the decision making process. It affects the control over emotions, body temperature, appetite and consciousness. Alcohol leads to dangerous conditions like Cirrhosis of liver, heart ailments, ulcerative stomach, cancer of mouth and nervous disorders. It is fatal if mixed with sedatives and tranquilizers and there are more than 150 such medications!



Mrs. Ravneet Kaur gave some positive qualities of alcohol, like it is good for bed sores. It is useful as antiseptic & disinfectant, hypnotic sedative and astringent. One should not have more than 60 ml of drinks per day. She concluded, "You should know your drink and should be wise enough to know when to say no."
