proceedings.

Dr. Rita's presentation began with Rotary being described in glowing terms to provide yeoman service to the community. Contributing to Rotary Foundation results in making clubs stronger, communities better, peace possible, eradication of poverty, illiteracy and malnutrition, and transforming our contributions into projects that change lives. The various modes of contribution are;

- Sustaining Member, when you give \$100 or more per year to the Annual Fund.
- Benefactor, when you include the Endowment Fund as a beneficiary in your estate plans or when you donate \$1,000 or more to the fund outright.
- Paul Harris Fellow, when you give \$1,000 or more to the Annual Fund, Polio Plus, or an approved Foundation grant.
- Multiple Paul Harris Fellow with each additional gift of \$1,000.
- Paul Harris Society member, when you give \$1,000 or more annually.

Rita also explained the various recognitions that one gets by contributing to TRF. The presentation also explained the concept of 'Every Rotarian Each Year' (EREY). She said, "God could not be everywhere, So He created mothers. But every child could not be blessed with motherly love. So He created Rotary! With TRF contributions, you change lives of needy children for the better, and it won't be long until you realize that they have done the same for you!"

Computer Course for girls and Refrigeration Electrician training for boys

Rotary Club Chandigarh Midtown shall be starting New Vocational Project of Computer Training Course for girls at Khuda Alisher during December 2013. At present about 30 girls are interested to take up this course. This course shall be of 3 to 4 months duration, thrice a week. Computer training shall be run under guidance of trained instructor and we shall be charging a nominal fee of Rs. 50/- per month from each girl. After completion of course, all students shall be given certificates which will help them to get employment to make them independent to earn their livelihood.

Another Vocational project of training Refrigeration Electricians shall

be taken up at Khudha Lahora by our Club very soon and same shall be run under guidance of trained instructor for three months, twice a week. Training shall be provided to 10 boys for a fee of Rs. 50/- per month per trainee. On completion of programme, they will be given certificates to enable them to become independent in earning their livelihood.

As per decision taken in last board meeting of our club in November 2013, it was decided to appeal to all Rotarians of our club for recommending suitable candidates known to them for the above courses so that we complete these projects with success, and with larger participation from weaker section.
