

A formal introduction of District Governor Rakesh Aggarwal given by President Elect Rtn. R.T.P.S. Tulsi concluded with a musical note, "Chaudhvin ka chand ho, Ya aftaab ho, jo bhi hon tum, Khuda ki kasam lajawab ho." This prompted PDG

Shaju Peter to say, "I would consider Rakesh as perhaps the most unassuming and most self-effacing Governor of 3080, who has the capacity to smile his way through all the turmoil and storms."

Addressing a large gathering of Rotarians and their spouses, DG Rakesh Aggarwal acknowledged our club as the most vibrant one in the District. He expressed his happiness for all the three projects he had visited and said, "These are real good projects." Referring to our bulletin, DG expressed his delight saying that he goes through it every week. He observed, "Your bulletin is very regular – on time, very informative and very good. Congratulations to all of you."

He also complimented Rotarians for India becoming polio free. However he cautioned us to be vigilant as polio is still there in our neighbouring countries Pakistan and Afghanistan. Giving a worldwide update on polio eradication, he said African countries like Somalia and Kenya were polio free for last five years but this year there were 139 cases of polio. Therefore we have to ensure that children up to five years of age should be given polio vaccine on NIDs which will continue till 2018, when polio is expected to be eradicated globally. DG Rakesh also shared India's three-year polio-free

triumph in 'Polio-free Conclave 2014' organized by Rotary International at New Delhi on 29-30 March 2014, to commemorate India's victory over Polio and reaffirm Rotary's commitment to ending polio not just in India but from all parts of the world. The Hon'ble President of India Mr. Pranab Mukherjee was the Chief Guest on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2014 for the inaugural function. (A detailed report of this conclave appears in our bulletin No. 41).

He also talked of literacy program that Rotary International would be taking up after polio eradication. Under School Development Programs Rotary clubs will create model schools. The DG explained the **T-E-A-C-H** program which is about **T**eacher Support, **E** Learning, **A**dult Literacy, **C**hild Development and **H**appy Schools.

The DG thanked Rtn. Salil Bali and R'ann Parul Bali for taking nice care of them as their Aides. He complimented our club for having wonderful projects and concluded, "You are the best club in this region."


