Know Your Projects **Home Care Nursing** **Immediate requirement of 10 girls for training**

For nearly 16 years, we have been running the Home Care Nursing project in association with the Inner Wheel Club of Chandigarh Midtown. The concept is to train young girls from the economically disadvantaged sections of society in nursing care with the idea that after completion of the one year training they could be gainfully employed and become self supporting.

We have been training 12-16 girls every year. The training centre is the Dr. Vikrant Gupta memorial trust run by our Charter President Dr. B.D. Gupta, in Sector 15, Chandigarh. The girls after their course are hired by households for looking after terminally ill patients in their homes. The girls are taught human physiology and other skills like making bed, nursing and feeding the sick, measuring blood pressure, giving injections, first aid etc.

At the end of the course each student is given a medical kit which would contain a stethoscope, blood pressure measuring instrument, first aid kit etc. The kits are funded by the Rotary Club of Chandigarh Midtown.

PP Prem Anand, Chair, Home Care Nursing Committee informs that there is an immediate requirement of 10 girls for the 17th Batch of Home Care Nursing Course. Anybody who will bring one student or motivate her to do this vocational course will be suitably rewarded.

RI Board decides on Enactment moved by PDG Shaju at COL 2013

Rotarians of Chandigarh Midtown might recall the presentation made by PDG Shaju Peter representative of District 3080 to COL 2013 held in April 2013 at Chicago, where he argued passionately to add a 5th part to the object of Rotary to reflect Rotary's commitment to youth. The Council had felt that the draft adopted as a compromise legislation was deficient and hence it was decided to refer the matter to the RI Board. Accordingly the RI Board considered the proposed enactment in its June 2013 meeting and decided to move the following enactment as a proposal by the Board of Directors of RI to the 2016 Council:

"We are life members of Blind Institute, Sector 26, Chandigarh for the last 15 years. Before joining Rotary Club Chandigarh Midtown, we both (myself and my wife, R'ann Sudha Puri) were regularly visiting this institute and used to participate in their projects like construction of girls hostel and other vocational projects etc., both physically and financially. We used to have frequent interactions with their Senior Vice President, Major General Rajender Nath (Retd.) and Principal K.R. Sood about various activities of the institute.

During beginning of 2010 we came to know that three blind children namely Aasma, along with her younger sister Halima and brother Israel, children of Mr. Aziz Ahmed and Husani Begum from Manimajra, Chandigarh were studying in this institute. Aasma also took part in State as well as National Games, and brought laurels to institute as well as Chandigarh by winning many gold medals. She always remained first division in every class/Board exam. We came to know that she is very interested to pursue her studies beyond 10+2 if somebody helps her financially for annual fees and hostel fees for completing her three years BA course in Govt. College for Women,

To add a 5th part to the object of Rotary to read, "The empowerment of a new generation of global leaders through service, mentorship, international exchange, and leadership development opportunities".

Congratulations Shaju for 'almost' winning the battle, and for bringing honor to our club. He deserves a big applause not only from our club, but from District 3080 as well!

The communication to this effect has been received by President Deepak Sood and District Governor Rakesh Aggarwal from Sharon Cyr, Manager, Rotary International Programmes on August 03, 2013.

Chandigarh. Her parents did not have enough resources for her education. We talked to the Principal and we agreed to sponsor the education of Aasma by paying her fees of around Rs. 15000/- for 3 years, through the Institute, to enable this talented girl to complete her BA Degree.

Few days back in July 2013, we got the information from Aasma that she has passed her final BA exam with 70% marks. We have given our consent to the institute and her to support her financially so that she completes her M.A. Degree."


