Cocktail of Medical and Folk Humour

Time: 6.30 p.m.

In the Club meeting on December 26, 2014, chief guest Dr. S.S. Moudgil, who was accompanied by his wife, was welcomed by President Rtn. R.T.P.S. Tulsi with a round of applause. He was introduced by PP Rtn. Pallav Mukherjee. Dr. Moudgil obtained his MBBS degree from Government Medical College, Rohtak, in 1970, and bestowed with FCGP fellowship. He is a consulting physician. Till recently he was running a 30 bedded Nursing Home at Gohana, equipped with modern facilities like ultrasound, X-ray lab and operation theatre. He is also a writer, poet, story teller and a columnist. He had appeared in TV debates, and participated in mushiaras on TV. He is widely travelled abroad and in India. He is Ex-Director of Haryana Sahitya Academy Panchkula. His 25 books have been published in English, Hindi, Punjabi and Haryanvi. He has received Chikitsa Ratan award from Indian Medical Association, Pt. Lakhmi Chand Award, the highest state award for folk literature and folk culture by Haryana Sahitya Academy and many other awards and recognition as a medical doctor, writer and a poet.

Dr. Moudgil started his talk with a couplet, "Mein na mazab likhta hun, na jaat likhta hun, dil mein jo aa jaye, bus wohi baat likhta hoon. Mujh se aaj bhi kuch umeed na rakhna, mein aaj bhi din ko din aur raat ko raat likhta hun."

He narrated how educated children behave with their illiterate parents, and how the parents react. A son who passed out of a university keeps two ladoos before his mother, and says these are three. The mother does not agree but the son says that he will prove that these are three, and starts counting one and two, that makes it three! This act of smartness he repeated 4-5 times. The illiterate father entered the house after labouring the whole day in his farm. He does not argue with his highly educated son. He picks up one ladoo, and gives second one to the mother. He then tells his son, "Beta, teesra ladoo tu khaa le."

Dr. Moudgil says that no matter how highly we are educated, whatever we do should benefit the public. He said no animal can laugh but laughter is a privilege given to human beings only, and explained the importance of being happy and laughing as this keeps us away from the stress that we face in our daily life. He said, "The society gives us stress, and to relieve that stress we laugh." Here Dr. Moudgil narrates another incident where a Haryanvi farmer had explained to him that there are two types of societies, one is cooperative and other is a marketing society. One will take Rs. 100/-, and give back Rs. 60/-, the other will give a loan of Rs. 60/-, and will not leave you without taking away Rs. 100/- from you! He

says, "Society is 'so saathi', 100 ke 60 kar deti hai, aur 60 ke 100." He said we should know how to deal with stress, and pointed out that there are three types of people who are known for overcoming stress. They are Scottish, Punjabis and Haryanvis. Historically, they are the ones who know how to fight! Elaborating on the importance of humour in our life, Dr. Moudgil gave many stress busting jokes based on facts and on his life experience as a doctor and a writer-poet.

Dr. Moudgil also told us some medical jokes and factual incidents, which he faced from his patients. "Pathri to x-ray may hai, mere may nahi," a lady tells her husband and that the doctor will unnecessarily cut her stomach, and charge a hefty fee!

In olden days there were many thrasher accidents resulting in arm amputations. A patient came to Dr. Moudgil with left arm badly injured in a thrasher accident. He tried to inspire the patient by telling him that it is good that his right hand is safe. The patient, still in pain, says, "Doctor sahib aaya to sajja hath hi tha, main ne kad ke khaba pa diya." So, one can also find humour in difficult situation, and get relieved of it!

Rtn. Prof. Dr. I.S. Dua thanked Dr. Moudgil on behalf of our club. He said, "Dr. Moudgil has opened the box of his mind to make us all happy. He has rightly pointed out that humour is the best way of life."


