Headaches - how to face them

In our regular meeting on June 05, 2015 Chief Guest Dr. Vivek Lal, Professor and Head, Neurology, PGI, Chandigarh was introduced by PP Rtn. T.S. Anand. After doing his MBBS, Dr. Lal did MD (Medicine) and DM (Neurology). His area of expertise is Headache & Migraine, Neuro-ophthalmology, Optic neuropathy, Retinal vascular occlusions and Occipital infarction. He has contributed numerous papers in various national and international journals. He has presented his research work in various conferences. As member of various professional associations, he actively participates in CMEs and Orations. He is a life member of the Neurological Society of India and life member of the Indian Academy of Neurology.

Dr. Lal had earlier addressed our meeting on March 12, 2010 when he was introduced by our present President, Rtn. R.T.P.S. Tulsi who had said, "Dr. Lal has a Rotary connection as a member of GSE Team." In that meeting Dr. Lal

had given a very interesting presentation on 'Reincarnation – Does it Exist?'. This time before his presentation on 'Headaches', he remarked, "Whenever I am among Rotarians, I really get very nostalgic." He took us down the memory lane describing how he had come across a retired senior IAS officer, Mr. J.D. Sharma, in connection with settling a two year old girl child whose mother was his patient and had expired, and the father abandoned the child in PGI. Dr. Lal's efforts resulted in the child finally being adopted by an extremely rich family from USA. Mr. Sharma who appeared to be having a 'to the point' attitude, and a practical person, called Dr. Lal one day to inform him that his name has been nominated by Rotary Club of Panchkula, and that he is to go to Ambala to appear before a GSE Selection Committee of Rotary District 3080 comprising of Rotarians Yash Das, Shaju Peter, Arun Sharma and Devinder Kalra. Not having any idea about GSE Team or Rotary, he appeared for the interview, and got selected! He shared his very pleasant memories about being a member of the 1994-95 GSE Team for UK, where he did not give his presentation about his own

subject, Neurology, but on Reincarnation. People of western world do not believe in incarnation, yet Dr. Lal's presentation created a good impact amongst the Englishmen.

Explaining what headache is, Dr. Lal defined it as a pain arising from the head. The pain originates from the tissues and structures that surround the brain which gives rise to the sensation of pain. Pain may be a dull ache, sharp, throbbing, constant, mild or intense. All headaches are not the same. It may be due to migraine, brain tumor, sinus, eye problem or tension. Practically everyone including children and young persons have headache. Dr. Lal also discussed tension type headache which may be due to lack of sleep, skipping meals, or an increased amount of stress.

He discussed the various factors which may cause headache. The major reason may not be sinus or cervical spondylosis. The reason behind 90 per cent of these headaches is migraine, the rest 10 per cent are because of other factors.

Migraine headaches are typical headaches that can last for anywhere between a couple of hours to a couple of days. People who suffer from migraine headaches experience pain in a characteristic pattern around the head. Some patients also have additional symptoms like vomiting, seeing strange visual patterns, changes in hearing and sensitivity to light and sound. Migraine headaches are usually associated with sensitivity to light, sound and

The headache of a migraine often involves only one side of the head but in some cases, patients may experience pain bilaterally. The pain of migraine is often described as throbbing and it may be made worse with physical exertion. Upto 50% of migraine headaches are influenced by weather, and 45% show sinus symptoms. Migraine can also be caused by stress, fatigue, anxiety, change in weather conditions, alcohol consumption, change in eating or sleeping patterns and use of certain pharmacologic agents.

Dr. Lal also discussed the causes of headache in children which may be due to refractive errors, illnesses like sinusitis, cold, flu or ear infection and emotional factors. He adviced to avoid certain beverages and junk foods like pizzas and burgers.

Dr. Lal said that stress, obesity, lack of exercise and working till late night on laptop and facebook, are the reasons behind increasing incidence of persistent headaches. One should not ignore any headache, and should consult a doctor if headache persists for over two weeks, otherwise it may lead to permanent vision loss. Migraine and headaches are important cause of acute vision loss. Though treatable, some of the cases report very late.

At least 30 minutes of exercise or brisk walk daily is strongly recommended. Yoga and meditation also helps.




