Disaster and Delivery(Nepal Earthquake)



PDG Jagdish Rana

In our regular meeting on November 27, 2015 Chief Guest PDG Jagdish Rana was introduced by PDG Shaju Peter. He was the Governor of Rotary District 3080 in 1985-86. He is not a Rotarian now but his actions continue to be Rotary like. A widely travelled

person he did History (honours) and International law. He was Member of Parliament in Nepal from 1992 to 1998. He and his wife, Mrs. Bhuvan are settled in Mashobra (H.P.) and Kathmandu (Nepal), and they keep moving between these two places.

PDG Rana gave a talk about the disaster in Nepal where thousands of children and families are in urgent need of support following the devastating earthquake that hit Nepal on 25 April 2015. Nearly 9,000 people were killed, more than 23,000 injured and many left homeless after entire buildings were reduced to rubble. The first quake measured 7.8 on the Richter scale and its epicenter was identified at a distance of 80 km to the northwest of Kathmandu, the capital of Nepal. Bharatpur was the nearest major city to the main earthquake, 53 km from the epicenter. The second earthquake was somewhat less powerful at 6.6. It occurred 65 km east of

Kathmandu and its seismic focus lay at a depth of 10 km below the earth's surface. Over 38 aftershocks of magnitude of 4.5 or greater occurred on that day following the initial earthquake. Thousands of houses were destroyed across many districts of the country, with entire villages being flattened, especially those near the epicenter.

Mr. Rana said Prime Minister Narendra Modi had quickly come to Nepal's help after the devastating earthquake. As Nepal's immediate neighbour, India was the first to respond to the crisis, by providing relief within couple of hours of the earthquake. There was immediate dispatch of relief and rescue teams, including medical team, to Nepal. Air India reduced fares on flights bound for Kathmandu, and announced that it would also carry relief material on its flights

Indian Army's relief operations delivered relief materials to inaccessible areas. It also set up field hospitals to take care of the wounded. International relief organizations also played their role and provided shelter kits, food and water, and sanitation facilities. International Medical Corps provided orthopedic and rehabilitative care to injured people, working with local agencies to provide psychosocial support.

The apex Sikh body Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (SGPC) also sent food packets to the earthquake affected people of Nepal. Mr. Rana appreciated the efforts of the Sikhs, including those settled in Nepal who served meals (langar) as they were aware of the food needed by the Nepalese people, and worked alongside the local army to distribute food effectively to all victims.

Rotary also provided immediate relief activities not only through Rotary clubs in Nepal but also mobilized worldwide support from clubs in other countries.
