Inauguration of our Service Project – Community Toilet Block at Makhanmajra

The Adviser to the Administrator Mr. Vijay Kumar Dev was the Chief Guest for inauguration function when the toilet block project was opened for public use and formally handed over to village panchayat of Makhanmajra on January 12, 2016. President Rtn. Kanan Diwan informed that this signature project of our club was completed for total cost of Rs. 4.5 lakh. The toilet block also has a room for the caretaker who will ensure the maintenance and cleanliness of the facility, which has 3 seats and 2 wash basins each in both male and female sections. The President also acknowledged the contribution of generous donors and all Rotarians involved in the completion of this project.

Sarpanch Ram Singh thanked our club for taking up the task of toilet construction which was long pending as it was abandoned and lying wasted at the entrance of the village.

Chief Guest Mr. Vijay Kumar Dev appreciated the initiative taken by our club to promote cleanliness in the city and surrounding areas, and to support Swachta campaign launched by Govt. of India by building toilets and hand wash stations. This toilet facility will change the outlook of residents of Makhanmajra towards sanitation and hygiene concepts. Since the ownership lies with the panchayat, they will have to ensure the maintenance and cleanliness of this facility. The Adviser said Rotary has been actively

involved in addressing challenges in society and this effort will spread the message of importance of sanitation in life of villagers and more people will associate themselves to make the city clean and beautiful. He said there is a need for joint effort of the citizens and the administration which can force the system to change to achieve the Swachta target.

Living One's Dreams

In our regular meeting on January 08, 2016 our Chief Guest Dr. Inderjit Singh Viridi spoke about Living One's Dreams. He was introduced by PP Rtn. Dr. V.J.S. Vohra. Dr. Viridi did his undergraduate and General Surgical Post Graduate studies at the Govt. Medical College, Patiala. Thereafter he went on to do his M.Ch in Cardiac Surgery from the PGI, Chandigarh. His further education and training was in England where he went as the British Heart Foundation Fellow and

obtained his FRCS from Edinburgh University. His senior cardiac surgical career started in St. Vincent's Hospital Sydney where he worked for almost 6 years. While in Australia, he also obtained his Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons. In India he has served in Apollo Hospital, Max hospital and Alchemist Hospital in Panchkula. He has published articles in several renowned journals and has trained scores of cardiac surgeons who are now running successful cardiac surgical programmes of their own.

President Rtn. Kanan Diwan welcomed our Chief Guest Dr. Viridi, his wife Mrs. Sonia Viridi and daughter, and all present in the meeting including Dr. Sajal Kakkar, an ecologist working with Apollo Hospital Hyderabad, who has now joined Max Hospital, Mohali.

A dream can become the goal of life. A dream is more likely to come true if it is clear in one's mind. The fulfillment of all of our dreams begins with intention and desire. As the sages of India observed thousands of years ago, our destiny is ultimately shaped by our deepest intentions and desires. As a passage from the Vedic text known as the Upanishads states, "You are what your deepest desire is. As your desire is, so is your intention. As your intention is, so is

your will. As your will is, so is your deed. As your deed is, so is your destiny." Walt Disney had said, "All our dreams can come true, if we have the courage to pursue them."

In his wonderful presentation Dr. Viridi explained the philosophy of life. With courage to go ahead makes one's dream come true. It was the world's first heart transplant done by Dr. Christiaan Barnard in 1967 that inspired Dr. Viridi, as a 14 year old student, to have a dream of becoming a heart transplant surgeon. It was fulfilled and he acknowledged the support of his teachers, senior colleagues, his mentors and his family. He made a special mention of the role played by his wife in the pursuit of his dream, which has been now fully achieved by having served professionally as a cardiac surgeon who has operated on more than 10,000 patients suffering from heart and lung ailments in Australia, UK and India during his 33 years career.

If one is focused of what one has to achieve the destiny would make it possible. Dr. Viridi said he is now going to fulfill his another dream of becoming a writer, and the way he has achieved great heights as a cardiac surgeon, he would certainly achieve his second dream too. Having been associated for 4 years with a Rotary Club in Australia, he may soon be joining us.

On behalf of our club IPP Rtn. R.T.P.S. Tulsi thanked Dr. Viridi for his excellent presentation.
