Annual awards

Fifth Justice Shacheendra Dwivedi Memorial Lecture

PP Rtn. Dr. Balram K. Gupta delivered the Fifth Justice Shacheendra Dwivedi Memorial Lecture at the National Law Institute University, Bhopal on March 18, 2016. First four lectures were delivered by late Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, former President of India, Professor Marc Galanter, Centennial Professor, London School of Economics and Political Science, U.K., Hon'ble Mr. Justice C.V. Sirpurkar, Judge, Supreme Court of India and Shri Colin Gonsalves, Senior Advocate, Supreme Court of India respectively. Justice Shacheendra Dwivedi was a Rotarian. He had made rich contribution in the domain of Constitutional Law both as a Lawyer and a Judge. He left behind a legacy. In order to perpetuate the legacy, this series of Memorial Lectures was instituted. Rtn. Dr. Gupta delivered the memorial lecture on : Building up Legal and Judicial Coparcenary on the touch stone of Rotary Culture and Values. In his lecture, Rtn. Dr. Gupta made specific reference to the Rotary International Council on Legislation which in the year 1989 laid down "Rotary Code of Conduct". According to the Code, Rotarians are to act with integrity and high ethical standards in their personal and professional life: and Rotarians will avoid behavior

which would reflect adversely on Rotary or other Rotarians. Dr. Gupta focused that this Code fits into the Code of Conduct of Judges. He suggested that the word Rotarian be substituted with Judge and Rotary with Judiciary. Truly, Judges and Lawyers must act with integrity and high ethical standards in their personal and professional life. Judges and lawyers must avoid behavior which would reflect adversely on them and on the institution of Judiciary.

Rotarians wear Rotary lapel. Lawyers and Judges wear their robs. Once you become a Judge or a Rotarian, automatically the Code becomes operational. Judges are not engines of power. In fact, they are engines of service. Service is their way of life. Their culture. So is true of Rotarians. The basic structure of Rotary is founded on service. Service to community, to humanity, to mankind. This mix leads to 'mosaic of service'.
