A talk on Kabir

Our own Rotarian Professor Rana Navar was the keynote speaker in our regular meeting on June 03, 2016 who gave a wonderful talk on Kabir. Professor Rana Nayar is a translator of poetry and short fiction from Punjabi to English. He has fourteen volumes of poetry and translation works to his credit. He is also a theatre artist and has participated in a number of major full-length productions. He was a Senior Lecturer and Head of Department of English at St. Bede's College in Shimla, before joining the Department of English & Cultural Studies, Panjab University, Chandigarh. He did M.A. in Philosophy from Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, M.A. in English from Baring Union Christian College, Batala, Punjab, and Ph.D in English in 1988 from Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla, He is a critic, scholar and translator. Prof. Nayar is a Charles Wallace (India) Trust Awardee, besides having won commendation awards for translation from British Council. In 2007 he won Sahitya Akademi's Indian Literature Golden Jubilee Literary Translation Prize for Poetry. He is also on the editorial board of the prestigious Lakeview International Journal of Literature and Arts.

In her welcome address President Kanan Diwan who had just returned from the Rotary International Convention at Seoul (Korea), said there were nine registrations from our club for the convention. She said that she and other members would share their memorable experience of the convention in the next regular meeting of our club on June 10, 2016.

President Kanan and PDG Yoginder Diwan visited the construction sites where the toilet project under the global grant received in May, has started in Model High School in Manimajra and it is hoped to complete this facility for girls by the end of this month with seven seats including a special one for disabled

girls. The construction of school rooms is also under progress. She thanked PP Indrajeet Sengupta who had taken the responsibility of looking after the project while they were away to Seoul. She said that we are still short of funds and therefore took this opportunity to thank IPP R.T.P.S. Tulsi and his brother Member of Parliament (Rajya Sabha) Mr. K.T.S. Tulsi for initiating the release of Rs. 10 lakh under MPLAD scheme which is likely to be received by our club shortly.

The President also announced the distribution of certificates to successful students of Home Care Nursing in Sector 15, Chandigarh on 9^{th} June 2016 at 11.00 a.m.

Prof. Rana Nayar started his talk with a remark, "This is my second chance of talking to you. First time I did not have the privilege of addressing you all as fellow Rotarians."

Prof. Nayar expressed his interest in Kabir because he offers basic solutions to problems that are faced in life. He discovered Kabir as not one, but many Kabirs. He was known as a preacher, as a social reformer and for the Kabir Panth. Everyone has some theory on Kabir. Prof. Nayar said, "I found Kabir to be a person of very high character, who is a voice that travels to us and speaks to all those who want to listen to him."


There are many stories about Kabir and his various ideologies. Kabir criticized caste system and declared the equality of all human beings. His early life is shrouded in mystery. He lived either towards the close of the 14th century or in the beginning of the 15th. It is said that he was born of a Hindu widow, and that he was then found and adopted by a Muslim weaver. When he grew up, he became disciple of Ramananda Swami. Kabir promoted a spirit of harmony between the Hindus and Muslims. He tried to emphasize the unity of Islam and Hinduism by preaching those virtues which were common to both religions.

Kabir made no distinction between Hindus and Muslims as Allah and Rama were different names for the same supreme being. He emphasized the equality and fraternity of all mankind. Kabir through his couplets reformed the mindset of common people to give them self confidence to question Brahmins. Kabir also denounced mullahs and their rituals. He strongly denounced the false superstitions, rituals and practices in all religions that had no relevance with the upliftment of human soul.

Kabir denounced the caste system. He said that there should be no discrimination on the basis of caste, and rejected the authority of both the Veda and the Koran. He laid great emphasis on the equality of men. He preached a religion of love which aimed at promoting unity amongst all castes and creeds. Kabir became an object of the wrath of both Hindus and Muslims. His straight forwardness and truthful frankness resulted in both the Hindu pandits and Muslim quazis holding grudges against him. They even tortured and humiliated Kabir which he took with calmness, but he remained firm in his views. It is worth noting that there is also a presence of a substantial amount of Kabir's verse in the Sikh Scripture, the Guru Granth Sahib by Guru Nanak Dev ji, the founder of the Sikh faith.

Secretary Sanjay Bhatia thanked Rtn. Professor Rana Nayar for enlightening us on Kabir. This being a very vast subject Sanjay expressed that we have another session with Prof. Nayar on this interesting topic.


